The most beautiful flowers ever seen in Brevard were on display at the Annual Flower Show on August 19th. This annual event, sponsored by the Brevard Garden Club, attracted hundreds of flower lovers from several States. Rows upon rows of tables were covered with almost every variety of flower grown in this area.
