JEAN KUYKENDALL  
POROSITY TEST

This test is made to determine rate of air flow through paper



BUVEE PARKER  
WEIGHT TEST

Weight as well as thickness must be uniform

HAZEL ARWOOD  
DRY STRENGTH TEST

A strip of paper the width of the circumference of a cigarette must support a weight of approximately eight pounds
