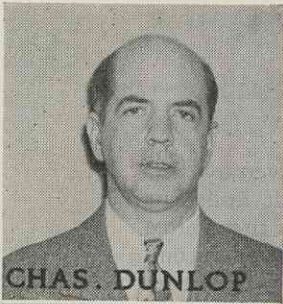


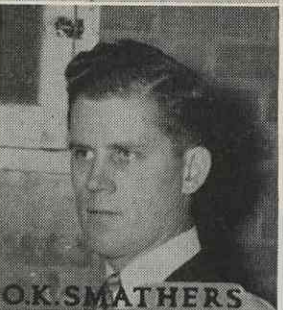

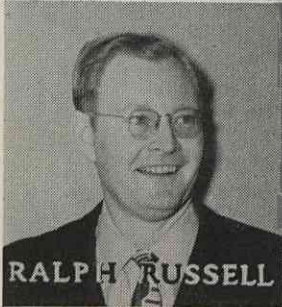

On these pages are shown the Ecusta employees who are adult leaders in the Daniel Boone Council of the Boy Scouts of America.



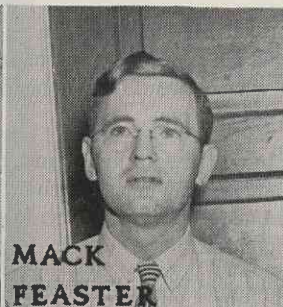
