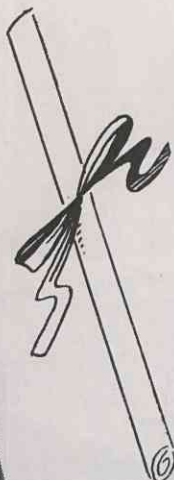


Our Graduates of 1950
