DON'T FORGET TO VOTE

Our Nation has always polled more votes in presidential years than in the so-called off-years, yet each election is very important to our welfare. On November 7th the American voters will go to the polls to elect United States senators, representatives, governors, and other state officials. in a country in which they could participate in its operation.

Ironically enough, however, there are thousands in this country who, given the right to vote, fail to take advantage of the opportunity it affords them. Remember, it is better to vote as you choose than to have someone tell you how you must vote. Making certain that you vote in every election is one way to insure your voting freedom.
