RETURN ON
OCTOBER 10

The Red Cross Bloodmobile will be in the basement of our Medical Center on October 10th and 11th. Pledge cards will be distributed again by the supervisor, and to eliminate unnecessary waiting time for donors the Medical Department is planning a definite schedule well in advance. It is hoped that we can set a record this time. Your blood is badly needed in Korea as well as at home.

Whole blood is flown regularly from the West Coast to Japan by Military Air Transport Service, and sent to Korea from there. Blood in excess of that required in the combat areas will be used for plasma and other derivations for military use.

Speedy and massive blood transfusions have proven extremely valuable in combatting shock suffered by the wounded in Korea. Shock usually results from loss of fluid from the blood circulation. It can also be caused by severe injuries or continued hemorrhage.
