UNIQUE AUTOMATIC WRIST WATCH

available. The entire container consists of just 2
pieces, and can be set up in only 2 minutes.

VERSATILE GOLF CLUB—Another new ad-
justable golf club is set to various pitches by a
dial on the clubhead. The manufacturer says the
new club is compact, well balanced, and easy to
adjust.

WATER RAZOR—Soaps, creams, or electricity
are not necessary shaving equipment, says the
manufacturer. The Fonta water razor fills with
water as a fountain pen does with ink and sup-
plies constant water lubrication to soften and raise
beard. It uses standard types of slotted wafer
blades.

CAN OPENER FOR TIRES—Operated like a
can opener, a new lever tool mounts or dismounts
auto tires. The handle of the tool is pushed up
and down around the rim of the wheel to take the
tire off, or put it on again.

CAN-O-MAT—Shipments are now under way
for a new "Can-O-Mat" wall-type can opener. The
unit features a single action handle that pierces
and opens cans automatically.

PAINT FOR CONCRETE FLOOR—"Oncrete
for Concrete," according to the manufacturer, has
high adhesion performance on concrete, brick, and
other porous masonry surfaces—inside and out-
side; because it is almost 100% free of driers and
oils. This gives it a strong resistance to the alkali
and moisture in concrete, which cause porch and
deck enamels to break down.

which can write in any of 6 colors—black, green,
orange, blue, yellow, and red, is the "66", recently
