

LONNIE JONES WINNER IN HAM SHOOT AT CAMP STRAUS



Lonnie Jones (Cellophane Coating), with a score of 23 out of a possible 30, won the grand prize in a Ham Shoot staged at Camp Straus on April 11. Five heats of ten riflemen each were staged with the winners of each heat competing in a run-off match for a 10-pound ham. Each winner of the individual heats received a nice sport shirt as a prize. The five heat winners and their scores were: 1st Heat—Lonnie Jones, 18; 2nd Heat—Harry Ballard 22; 3rd Heat—John Emory, 21; 4th Heat—Jesse Ashe, 18; 5th Heat—O. K. Smathers, 15. In the Winner's Heat the scores ran: Jones, 23; Smathers, 14; Ballard, 14; Ashe, 12; Emory, 0.
