The deserved reputation of the Ecusta Paper Corporation for advancing on to higher ground, year by year, is well exemplified by your splendidly organized blood program, culminating in the production of 450 pints of blood on July 15 and 16, 1953. Two thirds of this donation is being processed into Gamma Globulin for the prevention of paralytic polio and into Serum Albumin for our wounded. (Approximately 264 10cc units of Gamma Globulin and approximately 72 100cc units of Serum Albumin). One third of this donation will be used as whole blood in our regional hospitals.
