

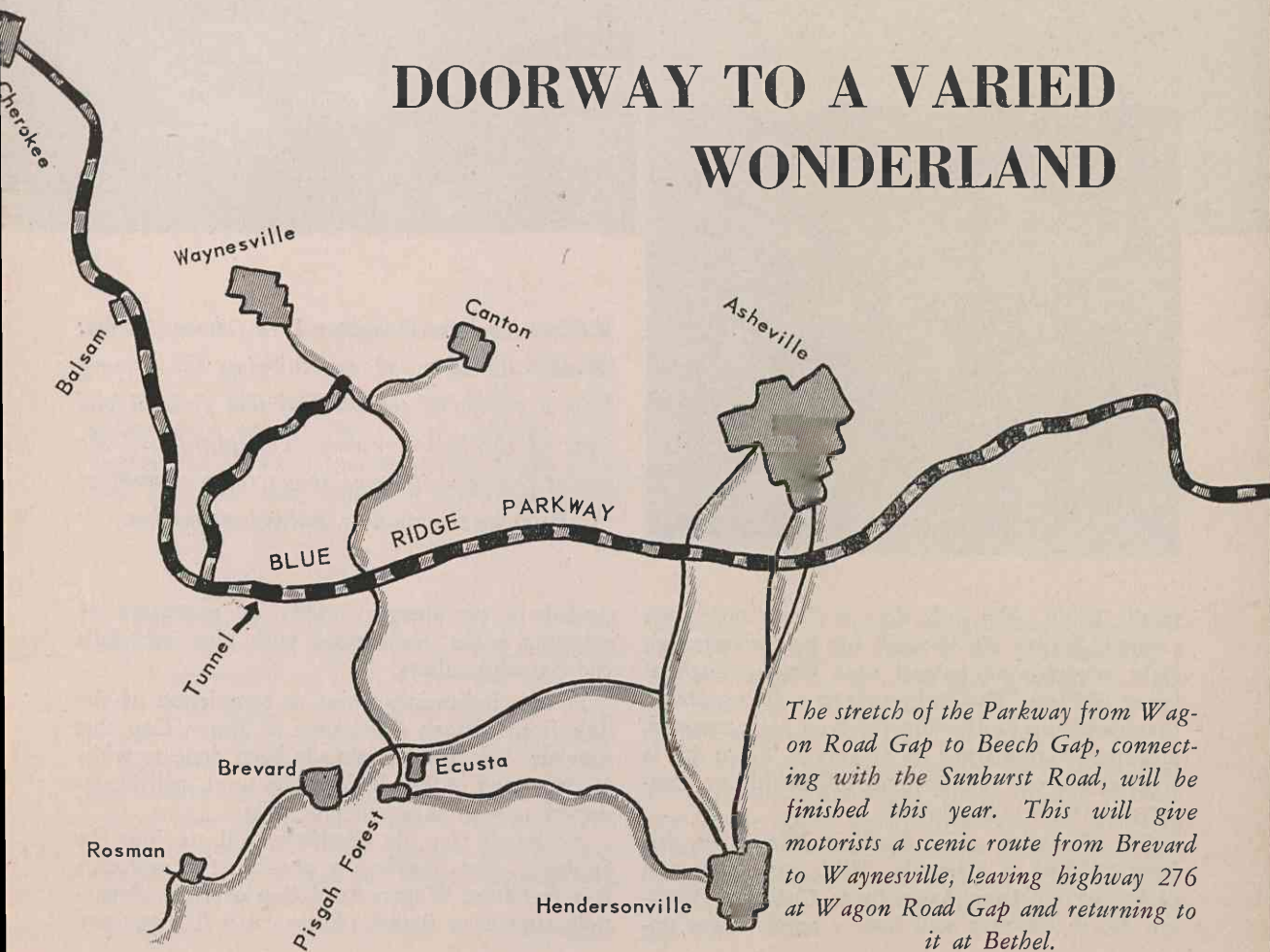
Rail Fences line the Parkway at Doughton Park.
