FOR SAFER WINTER DRIVING

Decrease speed to fit conditions of the weather.

Increase the margin of safety between your car and the car ahead or other objects.

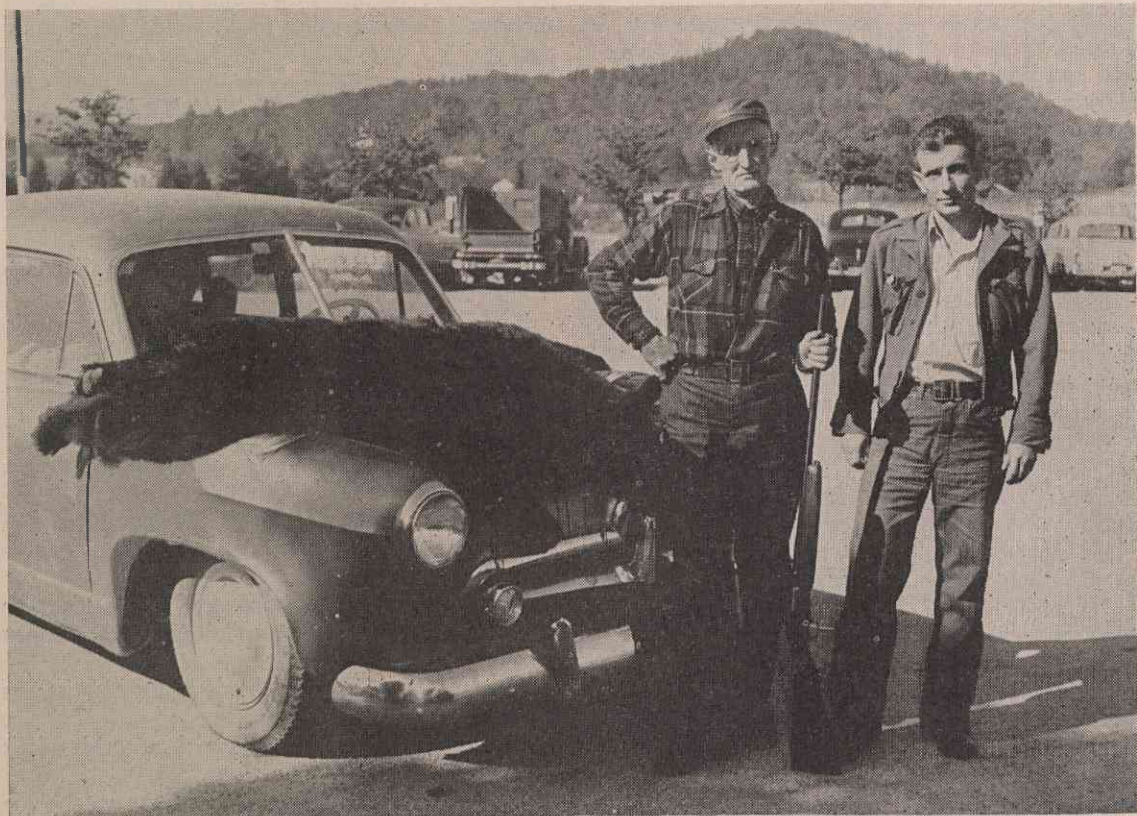
Do not apply brakes suddenly — gradual application helps prevent skidding.

In the event the car skids, turn front wheels in the direction of the skid. Keep windshield wipers and defroster in good working order. If windshield freezes preventing clear vision, pull over to side of road, stop, and clean windshield.

If your trip isn't absolutely necessary, don't start out driving in icy weather or a snow storm.
