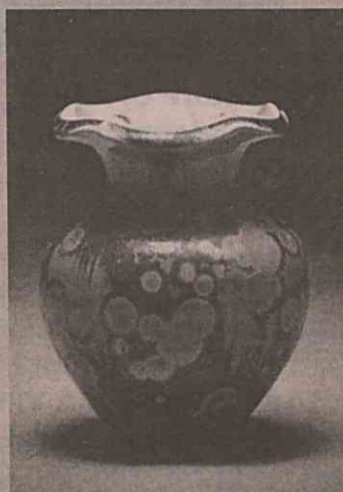

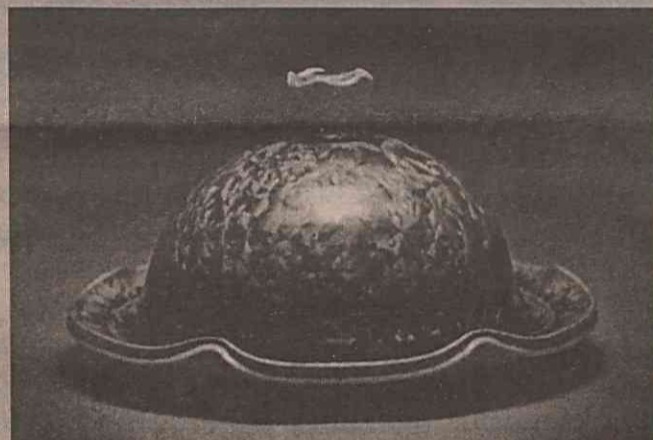


Two UNCA Student Ceramic Exhibitions Open May 2 in Owen Hall
