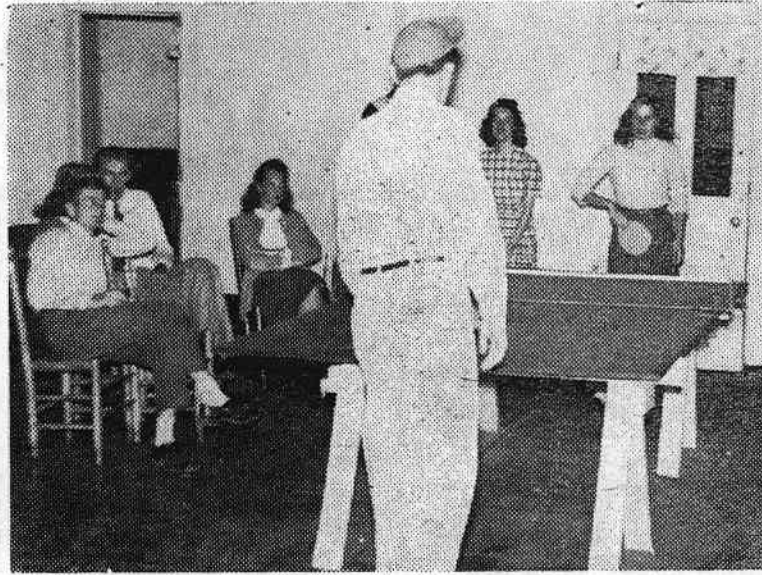
A Star
