Coach Chick Martin attended the annual NJCAA national meeting March 15-20 in Hutchinson, Kansas. The meeting is held in conjunction with the NJCAA basketball tournament. Coach Martin is the director of Region X, which includes 19 Junior Colleges from West Vir-ginia, Virginia, North Carolina, and South Carolina.

The main function of the meeting is to discuss national eligibility rules and regulations, to study the districts throughout the nation, and to work out athletic programs for national meets and tournaments. Other functions are to appraise bids from areas that want to host national events, and to set up a budget.

The directors, of which Coach Martin is one, control all sports held between NJCAA colleges.
