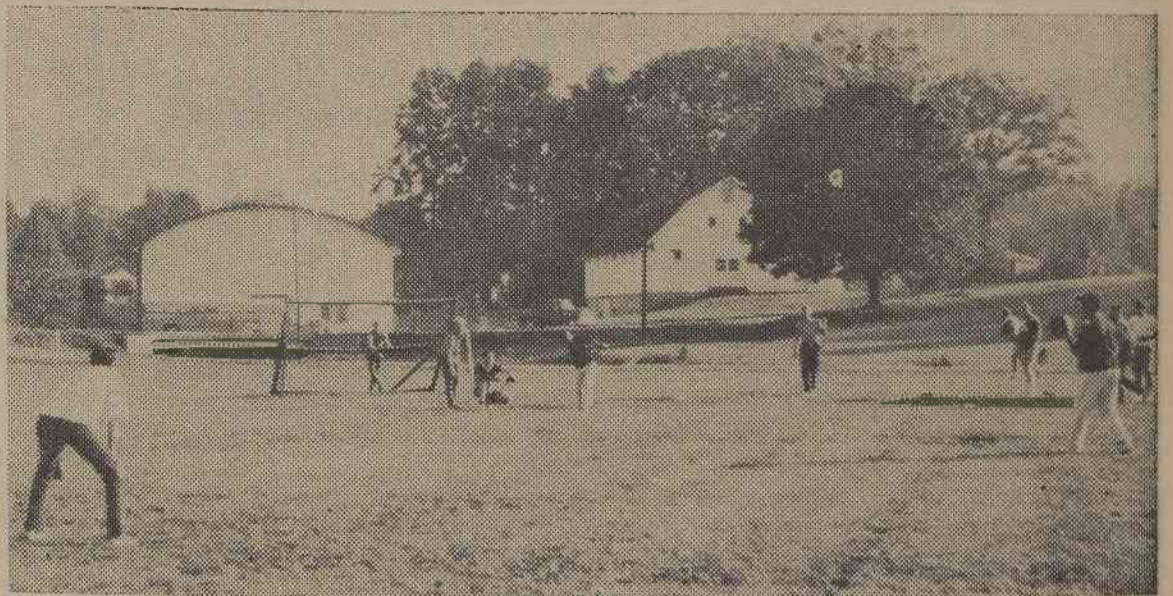




MISS VIRGINIA LYNCH takes a break in the Jones' parlor on a typical long day. Miss Lynch is this issue's student of the week.

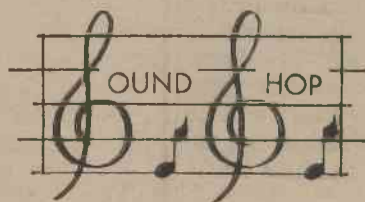
