because the rock is shaped similar to Caesar's head.

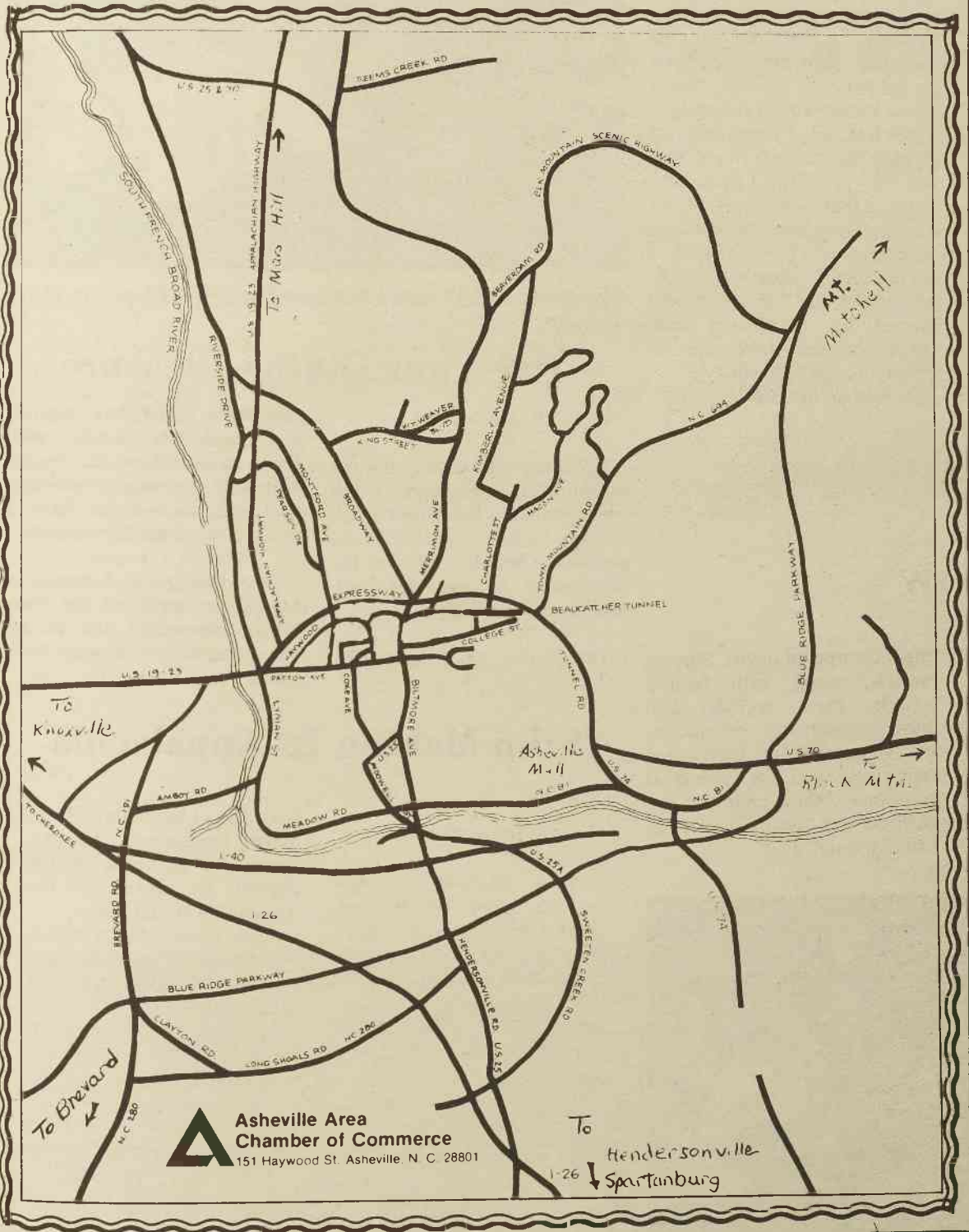
