

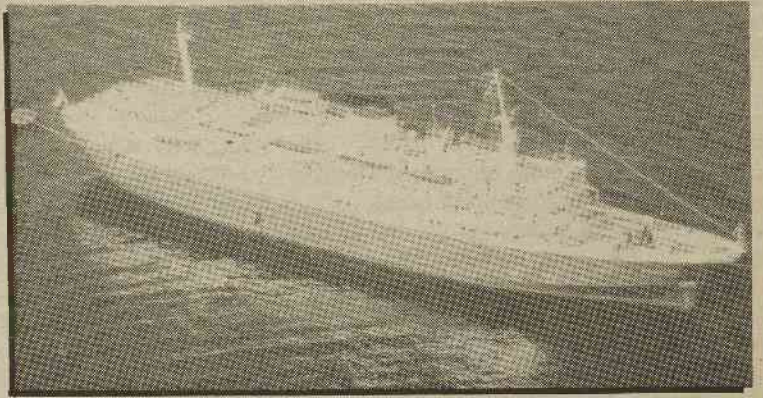
# Dr. Dunstan To Guide 30-Day European Tour

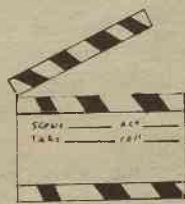

### Newman Portrays Troubled Lawyer

"Excellent, Sensational, Moving, A Triumph" - This is what critics are saying about *The Verdict*. Paul Newman's impressive performance as an alcoholic attorney makes *The Verdict* a "must see."

Lawyer Frank Galvin, forced to leave his law firm because of a scandal, has been reduced to ambulance chasing, and has lost every case in the past four years.
