We are on our way to creating a system that will make the contract more functional." Scarborough sees a need for a better way to track violations of Uniform Guidelines in the system. Points are a heavy factor against students on the contract. Uniform guidelines are enforced very heavily, as always. Scarborough is optimistic about the program and what it can do. "Learning contracts just make it harder to ignore your academic responsibilities," he said.

Klingensmith teaches CPR

"If you have taken CPR in the last year or so you need to take a refresher course," says Eric. "And if you haven't had CPR then take it—you could save a life."


