How To Apply for an Internship

Almost 75% of all college students have one internship and over 50% have two or more experiences prior to entering the job market. This statistic suggests that in order to be successful in job searches upon graduation, students should have experienced at least one internship. Those students who have not already located a position for the summer, should know that it is not too late. Just follow the four simple steps below.

1. **Locate potential positions** by searching through books and sites on the Internet.
2. **Update** or create your resume
3. **Include a cover letter** to let the potential employer know why the applicant is contacting them and why he or she would be an excellent selection for the internship position.
4. **Complete an interview**, either via phone or in person.
