Seniors: Read the syllabus to find out what classes they need to attend.

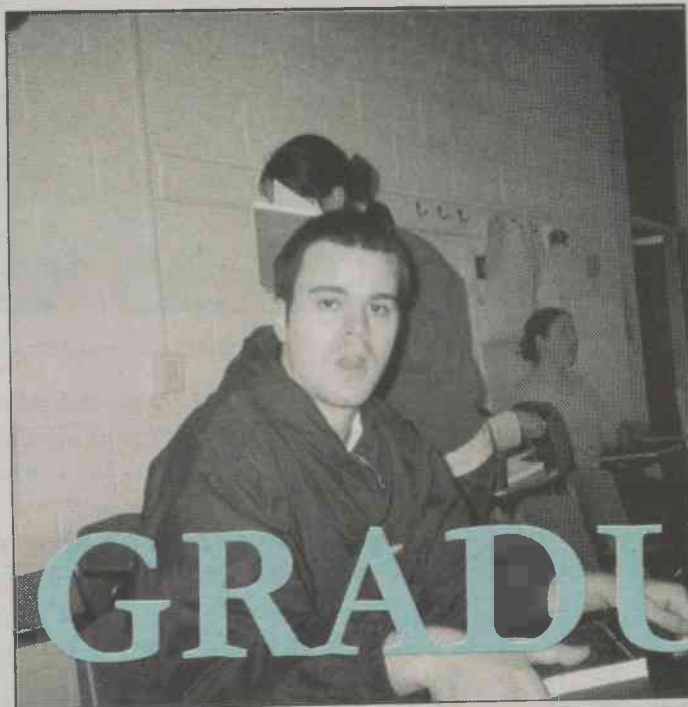
Freshmen: Bring a can of soda into a lecture hall.
