Brevard College's Comprehensive Campaign recently topped the \$12 million mark with the help of alumni, friends, faculty and staff.

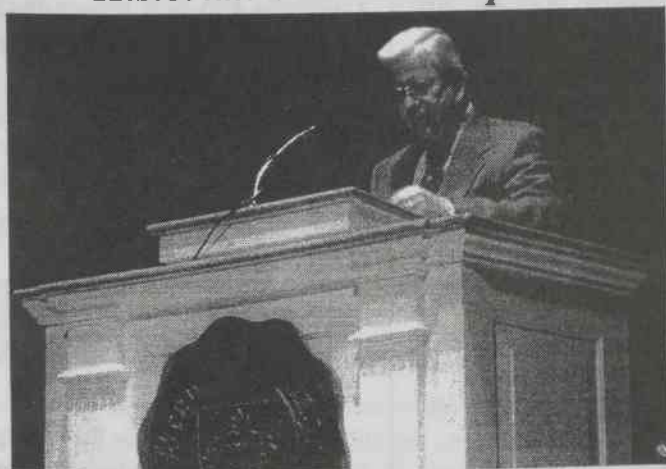
