



Car stolen from Green parking lot

Wednesday morning, September 26, BC student Andrew Irby called the Brevard Police Department to report that his black 2005 Jeep Cherokee had been stolen from the parking lot behind Green and Taylor halls.

According to Irby, the vehicle was last seen late the night before, and the following morning he noticed his car keys were missing from his desk.

BPD arrived on scene at approximately 9:45am and began the investigation. The

Police filed a report and issued a bulletin notifying all law enforcement agencies to be on

the look-out for the stolen vehicle.

A search of the campus was

conducted, but the vehicle was not located.

Around 6:30pm Wednesday night, Irby was with friends in the Brevard Rock Gym when police notified him that his vehicle had been located.

According to police, the vehicle was found crashed in Rosman. No further details about the damage to the car or the location of the crash were available at press time.

Police told Irby that an eyewitness had seen the crash and that two individuals had walked away from the scene and asked for a ride back to the Brevard College campus.

Police have not specified a suspect or person of interest at this time, but are continuing to investigate this incident and have several leads.

Irby believes that an intoxicated student may have entered his room late at night and taken his keys and vehicle. Also the victim of a theft last week, when his wallet and cell phone were stolen from his jeep while parked in DuPont State Forest, Irby is understandably shaken and irritated by the theft.
