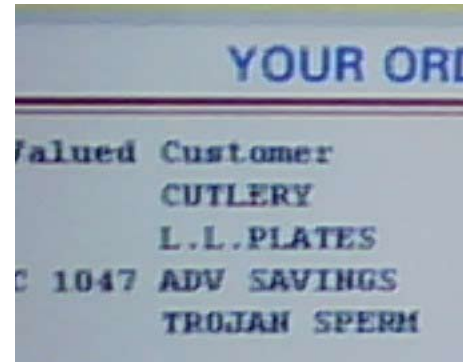


American Hero
