At the opening of the annual BC Art Faculty Group show last Friday, students learned what some of their professors do in their leisure. This is true of the current exhibition in Spiers Art Gallery, as the show is comprised of a mixture of different media and styles of the Brevard College Art Faculty. As these students demonstrate, "it is such a treat to see so much excellent artwork under one roof. From painting to sculpture to photography to other types of art, there are so many artistic areas covered," said Professor Michael Bryan.

Other work includes Jo Pumphrey's oil

paintings, consisting of a series of landscapes arranged in such a way to flow from one canvas to the next. Michael Bryan also has work in the gallery; natural and edited photographs of panoramic landscapes, taking the viewer beyond the lens of the camera.
