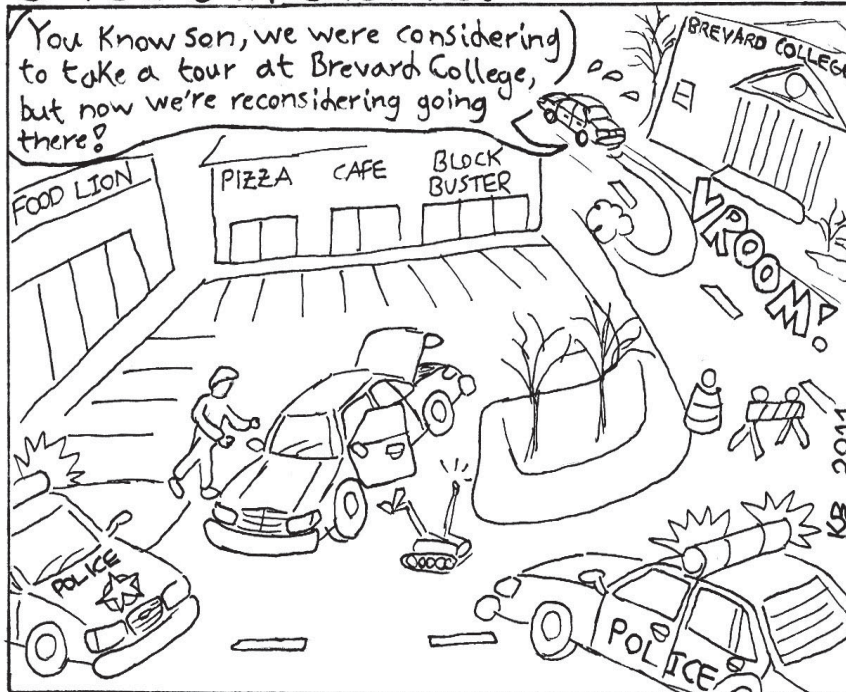


## CAR BOMB IN BREVARD?
