This is a great place to live, learn, and thrive and I look forward to all that we can accomplish working together next year! We are BC!

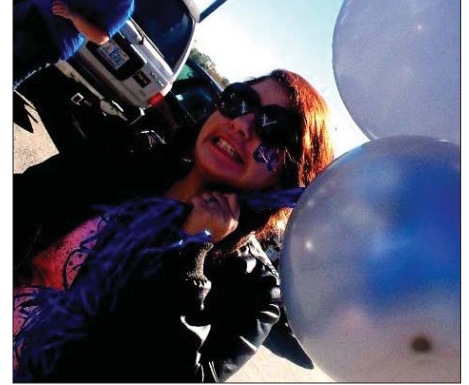


**Mark Moseley:**
