**Anything you want to say to the graduating class?:** "Do... or do not. There is no try." – Yoda in "The Empire Strikes Back."



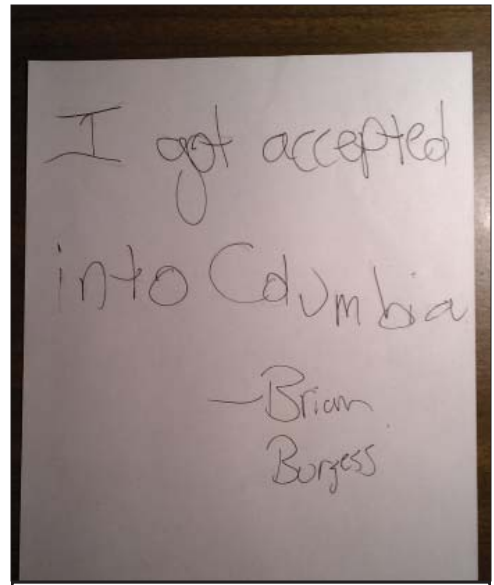
### Shane Apps
