Freshman Year (2007-2008)



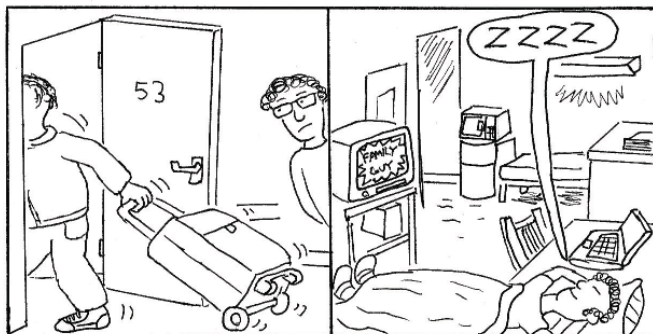

Sophomore Year (2008-2009)



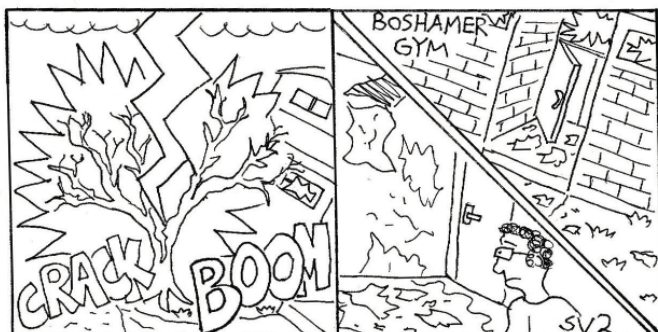
