mony, as well as the Harvey Beech and Travis Cooper Memorial Scholarship programs.

- Establish the initial stages of a BSM Archive.
- Outreach to members who are off-campus and members who cannot make the General Body meetings.
- Outreach to the local Black community by providing a listing of various community service opportunities that target Black populations.
- Begin work on improving the graduation rate of Black students.
- Providing a longer and more effective transition between this year's and next year's administration.

Consequently, if you are wondering what the BSM really is, you can track right along us. I would like to close by encouraging everyone to become involved in anything that you decide to join because you care. Your motivation should not be based on gaining the attention of certain organizations that you hope to join. It is painfully obvious to see who really cares about issues and who is solely seeking to have three letters across their chest. Do not tarnish any organization or program with the stigma of being merely a "recruiting ground." You are all too intelligent and talented to degrade yourselves to a shallow member of

a group.

In the meanwhile, continue to fight the good fight my fellow colleagues and I wish you all a blessed remainder of the semester.
