he month of November is Black Student Movement month and many students will celebrate it. But how many of you know the history of the organization you are celebrating?

This the 33rd year that the BSM has been in existence. It was founded in November of 1967 by Preston Dobbins as a branch off of the NAACP. In 1968, the Dixon Resolution and the Phillips Committee were established. The Dixon Resolution, written by Professor John Dixon and a five-person committee, soon became the framework of the BSM as we know it today. It's members proposed a list of 22 demands of the University. Among other things, the list called for a minimum of one black student to hear cases of black students in Honor Court and that the University more actively recruit minority professors. The list also included the demand for an official BSM week to promote awareness of the organization. Dilligence and determination on the part of BSM members has helped turn a demand for one week into the realization of an entire month dedicated to the Black Student Movement.
