MARK HERBERT, junior



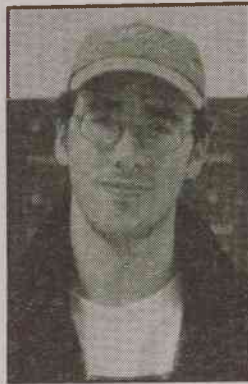
"Kenan parking is especially bad. It is tough for art students with all their supplies."
