FOREIGN AFFAIRS AND TRADE: foreign policy must be more than the management of crisis, concentrate on enduring national interests, expanding free trade within our hemisphere, supporting the entry of China/Taiwan into the World Trade Organization, launching new rounds of global trade talks, and enforcing American laws against unfair trade practices.
