

### **New Program At WSSU**

Welcome Freshmen and Returning Students!!! The Housing Management Program is a new addition to the Winston-Salem State University campus. Here is a brief review of our program and its history.

#### THE HOUSING MANAGEMENT PROGRAM **IN REVIEW**

Winston-Salem State University became the recipient of a \$135,000 Grant from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) on March 3, 1975. Winston-Salem State is one of five

Universities throughout the country in the HUD Program. The others are: Howard University of Washington, D.C., Temple University Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, Southern University of Baton Rogue, Louisiana, and Texas Southern of Houston, Texas.

The program at Winston-Salem State University has been designed to prepare highly qualified effective and managers. Participants will major Business in Administration with concentration in Housing Management. This Housing

Management Program has been designed to accommodate the following categories of students: (a) Housing Authority

Personnel. (b) Private Housing Personnel.

(c) Winston-Salem State University and other college students, and others interested in this general area of study.

Practitioners and other adults interested in upgrading skills, changing career paths, or gaining enrichment for selffulfillment, may enroll in one or more courses, workshops, or seminars for credit or non-credit.
