The secretary, by virtue of position, is Charlie Aycock, Director of Alumni Services and Parent Fund Coordinator. Other members of the initial council include Ms

Betty Edwards, Pendleton, N.C., Rev. Wayne Miller, Wake Forest, N.C. and Mr. and Mrs. Rodney Weston, Hopewell, Va.

Ultimately, the council aspires to govern the association with twenty parent families, including five parent families from each class of current
