

Irwin Belk Is Leader For Board Of Advisors

CHARLOTTE — An outstanding leader in North Carolina's educational, political and religious life for many years, Irwin Belk of Charlotte, is serving as chairman of Chowan College's Board of Advisors.

Currently serving in top leadership positions with eight church and religious organizations, he is known as one of North Carolina's outstanding champions of the cause of church-related college education. His leadership has been credited with aiding the growth and progress of many church-related colleges and educational institutions, and
