She had just returned from touring northeastern North Carolina and southeastern Virginia, taking Children's Theatre productions to more than 4,000 public school children, sang starring roles in "Showboat" and other Broadway-type musicals, starred in every Chowan Players' staging since becoming a Chowan student and – as the reigning Miss Warren County – competed this summer for the Miss North
