Graphic arts head honored

The director of Chowan College's School of Graphic Communications, Herman W. Gatewood, has received the highest award given by the North Carolina Press Association's Production Conference. Gatewood joined the faculty in 1963 and has served as the school's director since 1970.

The coveted Al Resch Award, citing Gatewood's "distinguished service," was presented at the conclusion of the 33rd annual meeting recently in Raleigh. A record 214 representatives from throughout North Carolina attended.

The award, provided by the family of the late Al Resch, publishers of *The News and Record* of Siler City, recognizes the individual who makes the largest service contribution to the workshop sessions to promote greater newspaper production efficiency. The citation was initiated by Resch, one of the founders of the Production Conference, who wanted to recognize those individuals who seek to "promote efficiency in mechanical newspaper production" by participation in the annual sessions at North Carolina State University.

Gatewood, who has participated in the conference for more than 20 years, is immediate past chairman and has served on the Executive Committee for the past four years. Following the 1986 meeting, he was re-elected to the Executive Committee for a three-year term and also elected to serve as treasurer.
