

Garrison beginning 34th years as head football coach

Head Football Coach Jim Garrison, beginning his 34th year, has announced the 1991 football schedule this season for the Chowan Braves. Last year the Braves finished with a five and four overall record, giving Garrison his 27th winning season. With an overall 182-136-12 record, Garrison is currently third among active coaches in the N.J.C.A.A. with career victories.

Chowan will feature a nine game schedule this season with five at home and four on the road.

The Braves who averaged over 28 points per game last season, will once again feature a high potent offense along with their traditionally strong defense.

Chowan will open their 1991 season at home September 7th, hosting the Shipbuilders of Newport News Apprentice School. Kickoff will be at 1:30 p.m.
