Chowan College has joined with fourteen major institutions in North Carolina to connect to CONCERT (Communications for North Carolina Education, Research, and Technology), a network which connects computers of major colleges and universities throughout the United States.

CONCERT, which is part of Internet, a national organization, will allow faculty and staff at Chowan to receive and send messages, research, and resources of interest to colleges and universities throughout the country. Called "E-Mail," Internet also includes archives and resources of interest to social scientists, musicians and other academicians. Many libraries are accessible, including the Library of Congress.

Internet connects to NASA Science Internet and many other state networks as well as European and Asian connections.

"This computer connection will be a valuable resources for faculty and staff on our campus," said Phyllis Dewar, professor of science at Chowan. "It will allow accessibility to resources we have not had in the past and make it easier to communicate with faculty and staff at other institutions."
