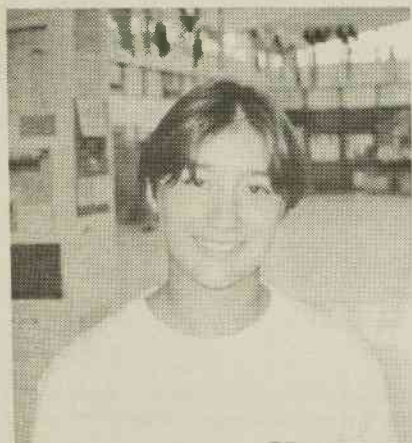


Why did you choose Methodist College? What has Methodist College offered you that other colleges could not?



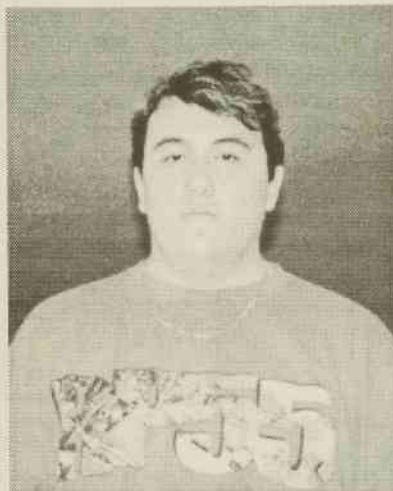

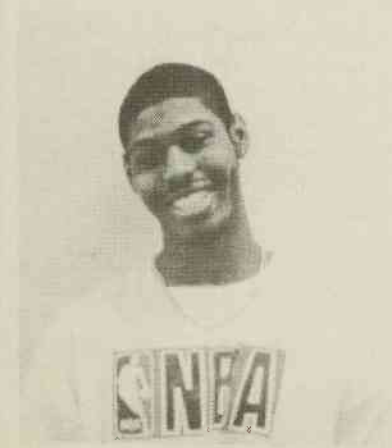
