DID YOU KNOW?

Among the 50 states, excluding Alaska and Washington, D. C. three states permit a boy to compete in an unlimited number of track events and three more have partial limitations. Seven states limit the men to five events, while 19 limit participation to four events, and 18 states limit men to three events for a state meet. Many states limit a man to the number of running events over 440 yards. Another interesting fact is that whereas the majority of the states specify opening starting dates for football and basketball, only 17 do the same for track, and only eight states and D. C. limit the number of meets in which a school may
