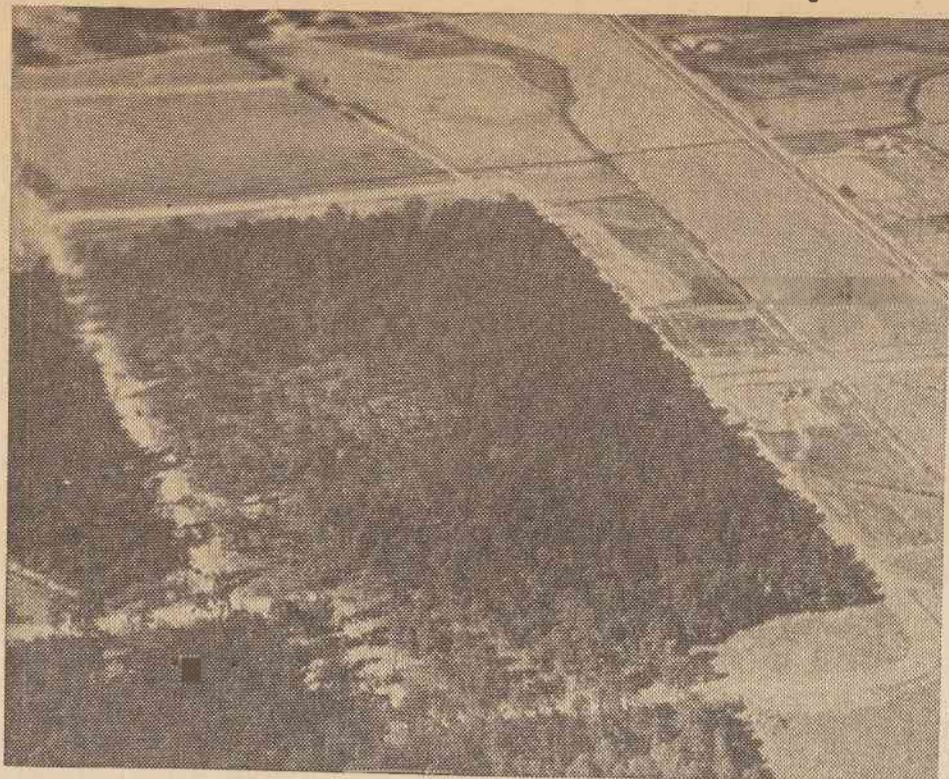
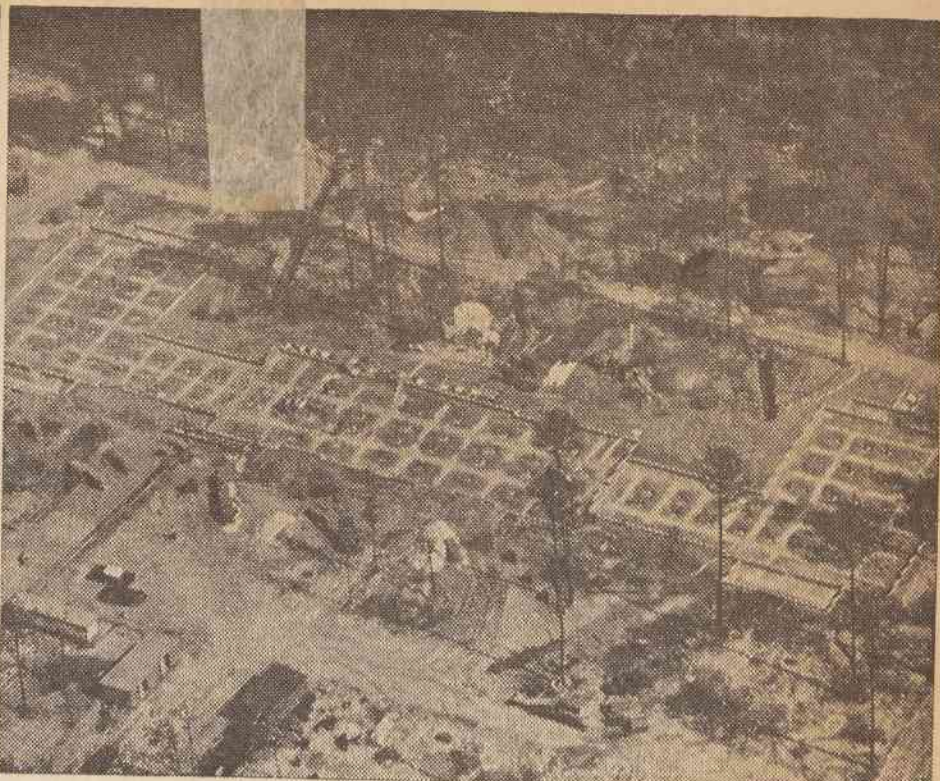

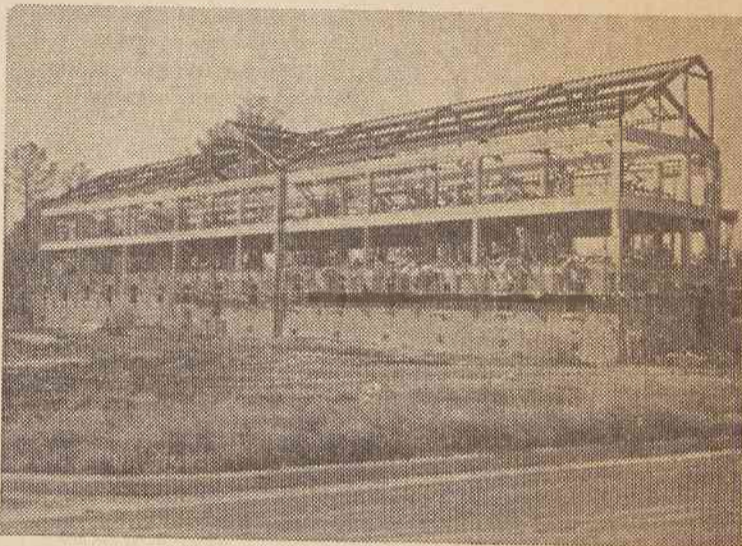
The Administration Building was completed in the fall of 1960, ready to greet the first class.

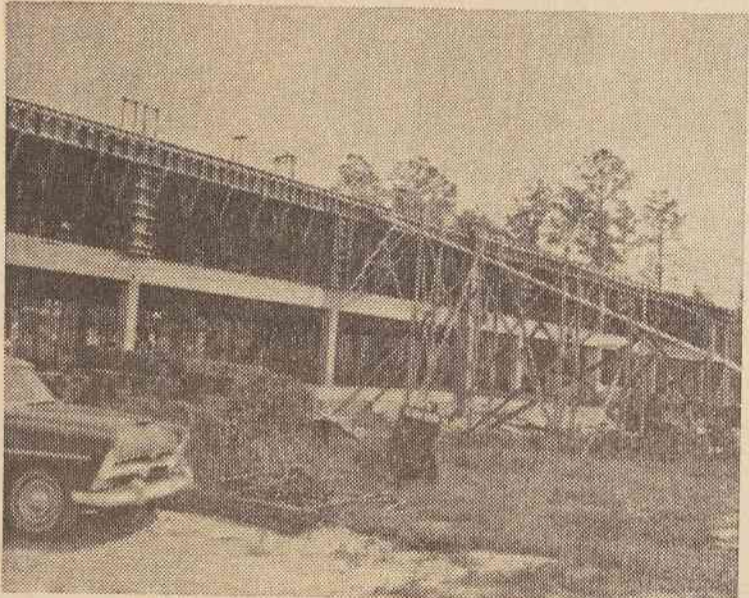
Two new dormitories are under construction now. As soon as they are completed, a gymnasium and an infirmary will appear, to be followed by additional dormitories, a library and a chapel.

Six years have passed since Wesleyan was founded, and two years have passed since construction first began. In that time, the new campus has taken on the appearance of a busy college looking to the future.

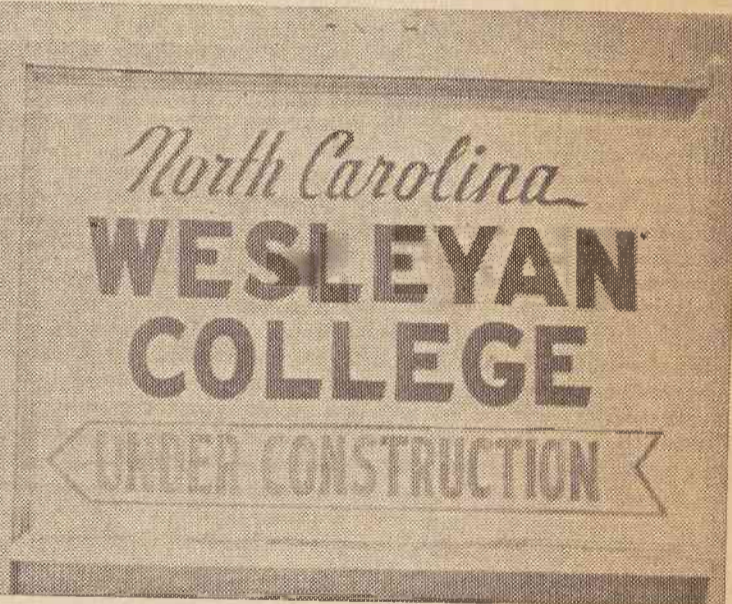
The foundation of the new college is firm. On its strong foundation, Wesleyan looks to the years ahead with confidence.



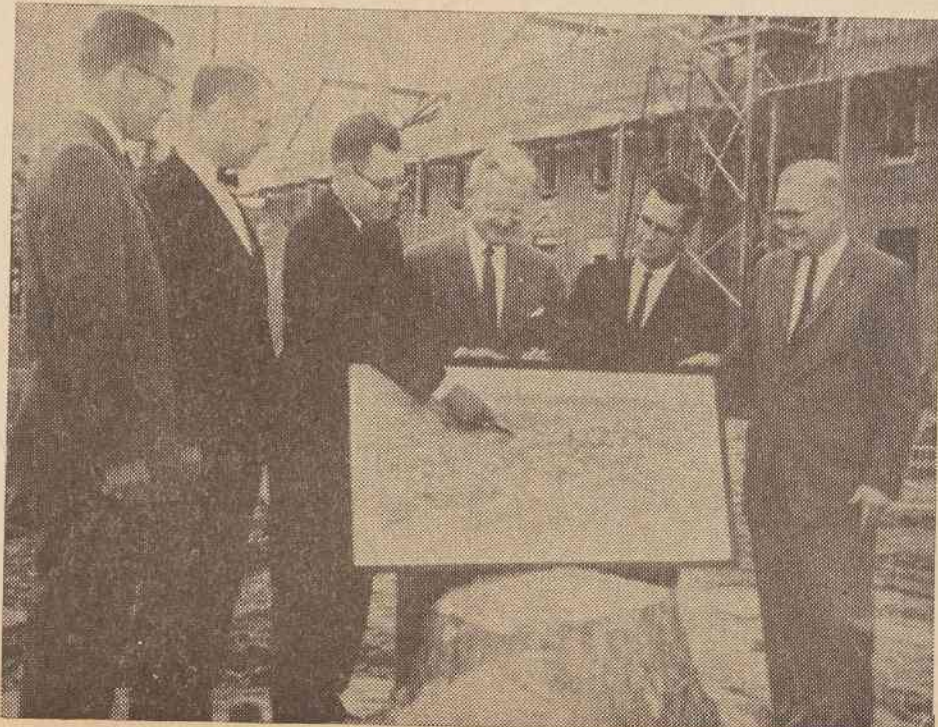
WORK PROGRESSES ON GIRLS' DORMITORY



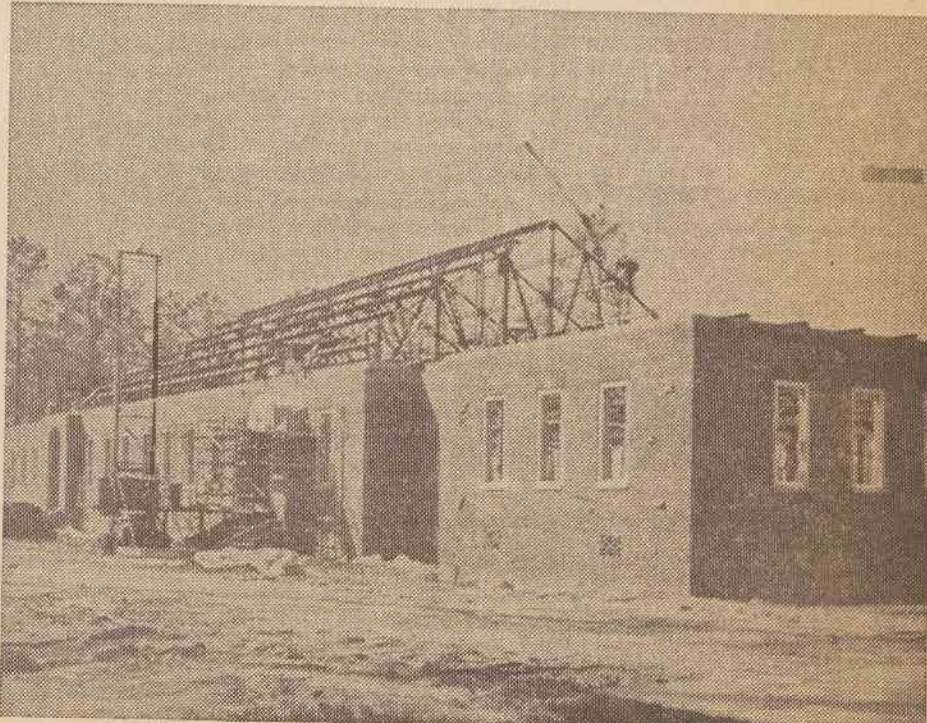
BOYS' DORMITORY IN EARLY BUILDING STAGE
