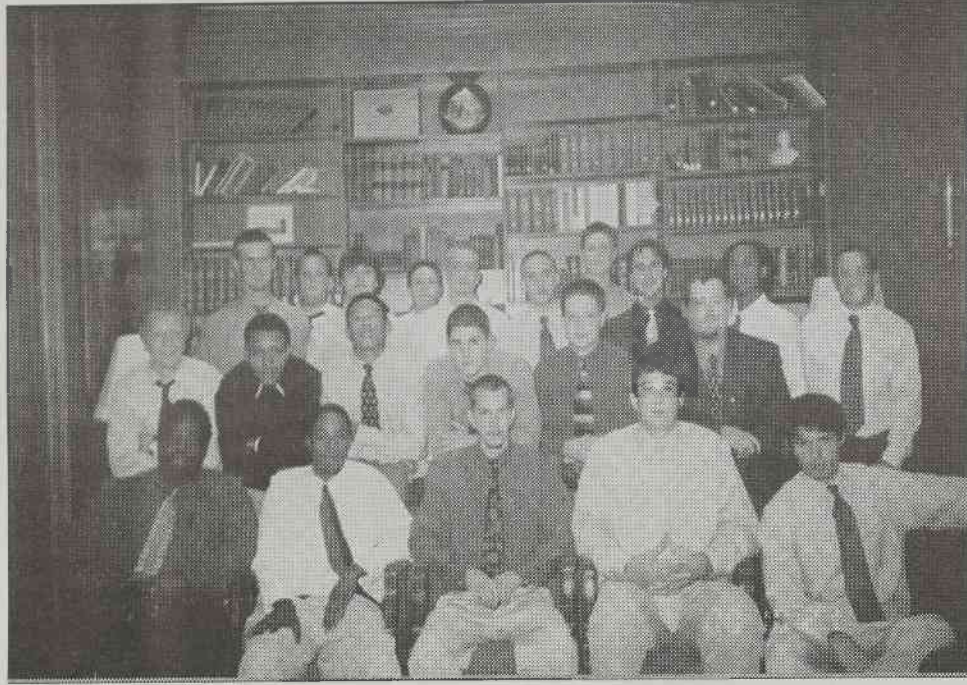


# Clubs

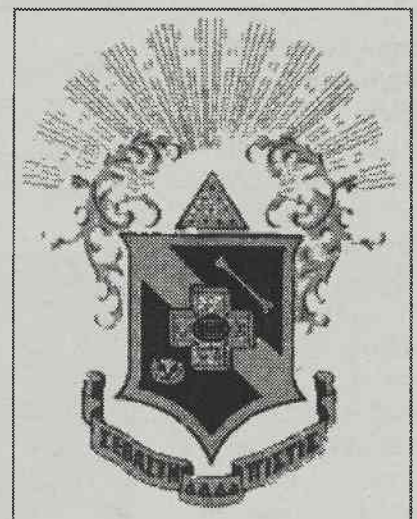
