Bennett Dale and Daniel Michael, both of whom entered service on May 26, 1953, have returned to their knitting machines at Plant #1. Although they entered service on the same day, their paths did not cross again until they returned to work.

After entering service on May 26, 1953, at Ft. Lee, Virginia, Bennett Dale was stationed there for 5 months, receiving his basic training and attending Quartermaster School. From Ft. Lee, he was sent to Hawaii to work in the Quartermaster Office. After 18 months in Hawaii, Bennett returned to the States through Oakland Army Base in California and was discharged from Ft. Jackson, S. C., on April 28, 1955. He is single and resides with his parents at 2110 English Street.

Daniel Michael entered service at Ft. Jackson, S. C., and was stationed there for six months, attending Radio School during that time. He was then sent to Japan where he served 16 months in radio-teletype work. On April 19, 1955, he returned to the States through Oakland Army Base and received his discharge at Ft.
