poration's plants in High Point will be given free chest X-rays on May 1, 2 and 3 at the English Street plants and May 11 at the Grimes Street plant. Employees desiring to take advantage of this free chest X-ray will be given time off for this purpose. The program is voluntary. Approximately 5 minutes will be sufficient time for you to have the X-ray made. You will be notified whether your chest X-ray shows any signs of tuberculosis, lung tumor or abnormal heart. No other person will be notified. The notification will be mailed to you directly from the Health Department.

The chest X-ray is simply a picture of your chest. You do not have to undress for the X-ray and as has been noted above, you will get a written report of the findings free of charge. The cost of this program is paid by the High Point Tuberculosis Association with funds derived from the sale of Christmas seals.

Since we do not want anyone to be away from his job any longer than necessary, it will be necessary for you to go at the time designated for your department. Your foreman will notify you when to go to the X-ray unit. Employees of the second shift may take advantage of the X-ray before reporting to work. In the event you are not working, or, for some other reason cannot have your X-ray made when your department is scheduled, you may report to the unit at another location. A schedule of locations will appear in the local newspaper. You are urged to invite your relatives, friends and neighbors to take advantage of this service here or at another location.
