CHECK LIST USED FOR QUALITY

The check list to guide the Quality Control Committee is as follows:
KNITTING - Check at machines for holes, misplaits, bad sizing and oil spots, or any other defect.
LOOPING - Check loopers for looper holes, brushing and oil spots.
INSPECTING - Check on clippers for clipper holes, clipping too short or

leaving too long and turning out tops.

DYE HOUSE - Check on shades in
stretch goods, mildew in other styles.

BOARDING - Check patterns, heel and
toe for bad boarding.

BERRY-PAK - Check for straightness, holes, misplaiting on Berry-Pak. Check clippers for leaving strings or cutting holes.

PAIRING - Check pairing, shades, holes, misplaiting or any other defect which might cause an off-grade.

FINISHING - Check transfer for centering and straightness, also riders.

Check machines for transfers, riders and bands. Check folders for neatness.
