

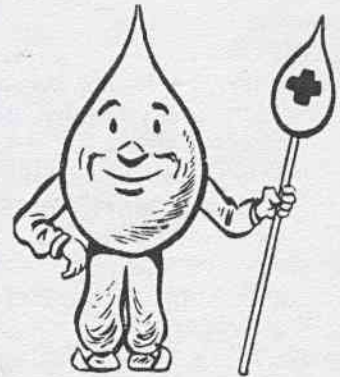

ADAMS-MILLIS EMPLOYEES GIVE 103 PINTS BLOOD

Employees of Adams-Millis plants and offices again answered the call of the American Red Cross for blood donors at the Red Cross Bloodmobile on February 16 and 17.
