ATHANAS NAMED PRESIDENT of MAC PANEL

Appointment of George L. Athanas as president of the MAC Panel Division of Adams-Millis has been announced by Pres. James H. Millis.

Athanas will take over MAC Panel operations on July 15, replacing H. O. Williams who moves to ex-
