Though far from forsaking the hosiery interests, Adams-Millis Corp. is pointing with pride to the way it brought the space age to High Point a few years ago by going into the computer equipment and magnetic tape business.

MAC Panel Co. was set up to find a market for control panels and wires for the booming data processing field. In a few years, not only were control panels and wire sales holding their own to the tune of a million dollars in sales annually, but several new products were added. Magnetic tape sales continue to climb and through Adams-Millis (Europe) Inc., the foreign-based subsidiary of MAC Panel, the High Point firm continues to corner its share of the highly complex computer tape market.
