Dear Myrtle,

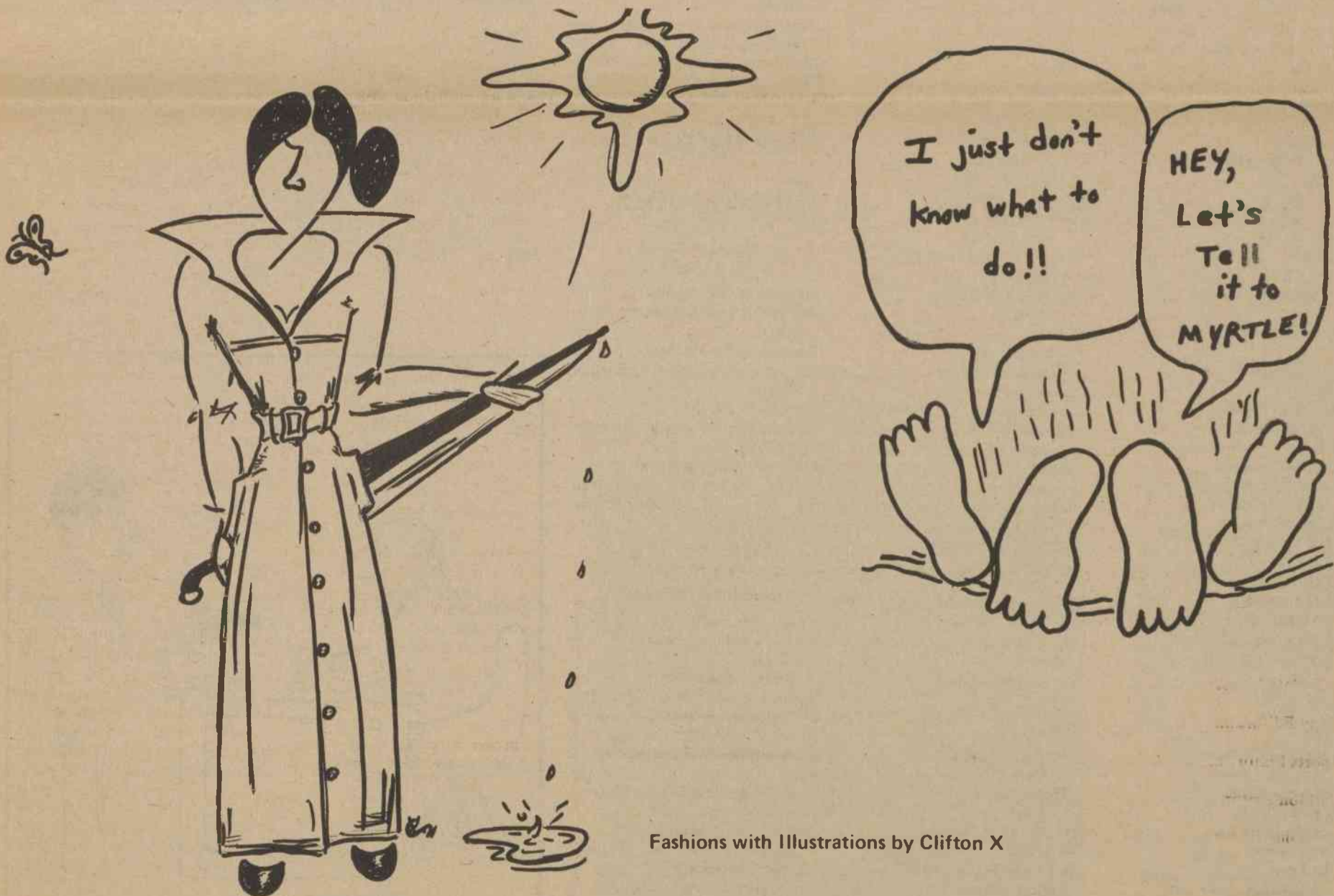
How can you tell your roommate that she has a terrible body odor, without hurting her feelings. I put up with it during the winter because I kept the windows open. I can't make it through the spring.
